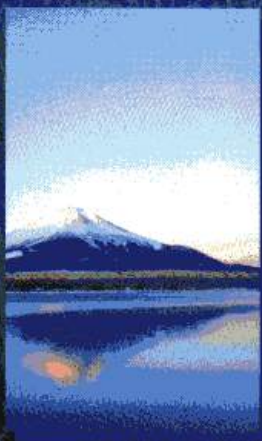


# Mt. Fuji & Fuji Five Lakes

富士山・富士五湖



*After boarding an expressway bus outside the west exit of Shinjuku Station, it takes less than two hours to reach the Fuji Five Lakes district at the base of Mt. Fuji, Japan's most exquisite mountain and spiritual center. Mt. Fuji's hot-springs will sooth your aches, and its four beautiful seasons will warmly welcome you.*

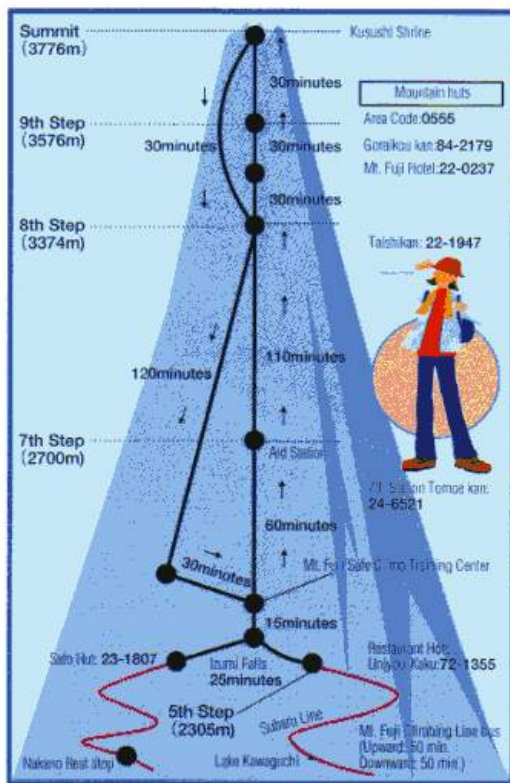
# Climbing the Mt. Fuji

Climbing the Mt. Fuji is allowed from July 1, the opening day, through Aug. 26, the closing day. Winter season climbing is dangerous and not allowed.

## Lake Kawaguchi Entrance Route

Standard climbing time : Upward 5 hours, Downward 3 hours

This is the most popular route where you will see dazzling alpine plants and rocky terrain as you climb through eighth station on your way up to Mt. Fuji. There are more than 15 mountain huts (reservations needed, please refer to the map below) where you can watch Mt. Fuji's shadow appear at dusk and sunrise. We especially recommend that you walk up the Gochu Path (starting from Mt. Fuji's Fifth Uphill Station) during the spring and autumn seasons.



- Precautions when you climb Mt. Fuji:
  - The appropriate season to climb Mt. Fuji is from July, after the rainy season, through mid August.
  - Be careful since the mountain's weather can change abruptly, and the higher you climb the more severe the weather may become.
  - You should always include resting time in your climbing itinerary.

- Accessing method
  - On board a non-stop Chuo Highway bus to the Fifth Uphill Station of Mt. Fuji from the West Exit of Shinjuku Station.
  - To the Lake Kawaguchi Station on board a Mt. Fuji Five Lakes Line bus of the Chuo Highway Bus and changing at the Lake Kawaguchi Station to a Mt. Fuji Climbing Line bus.

<Note> The service will be suspended during winter seasons.

- Starting point of the Mt. Fuji Climbing Line bus from the Lake Kawaguchi Station: Lake Kawaguchi Station of the Fujikyū Line
- Bus fare: One way ticket: ¥1,700. Return ticket: ¥2,000 (The fare will be a half for children.)

⑩富士急ハイランド **Fujikyū Highland** An all-round amusement park with a host of scream machines including the popular "FUJIYAMA" and the "Dodonpa" roller coaster that reaches speeds of 172 km/h.

⑫フジヤマミュージアム **Fujiyama Museum** An art gallery where visitors can enjoy various depictions of Mt. Fuji done by renowned modern painters such as Kaji Higashiyama and Taikan Yokoyama. In the main hall a High-Vision video presentation is shown that features the majestic natural beauty and allure of Mt. Fuji, as narrated by Koji Kinutani and Tamako Kataoka. The museum is a three-minute walk from the Fuji Express Highland Bus Terminal (access through the lower level first floor of the Hotel Highland Resort across from the bus stop).
