The Ueno Area is a place of striking contrasts. Below the railway is an exciting shopper's paradise of market stalls, restaurants and variety halls, while above on a pleasantly wooded hill, UENO PARK takes pride in hosting a number of Japan's top museums, along with modern cultural and recreational facilities, historic monuments and relics of the Edo and early Meiji Period.
